

Connecting People To Places in Northeast Eugene: A Summary of Survey Results

Introduction

As neighborhoods grow and develop, they change. Northeast Neighbors (NEN) wants to understand this growth in order to plan for the future. In the spring and summer of 2013 NEN collaborated with the City of Eugene to develop and conduct a survey to understand how people who live in Northeast Eugene get to the places they want to go. 641 residents completed the survey: 7% of the population in Northeast Eugene. This information will assist with efforts to improve safety and access to vital neighborhood and commercial areas in Northeast Eugene.

Methodology

The NEN Leadership Team composed of residents and stakeholders in Northeast Eugene, as well as a City of Eugene staff team, worked together to develop an online and hard copy survey. The survey was conducted both online (via Survey Monkey) and as a hard copy. Distribution methods included:

- Link to survey in several NEN e-newsletters to 162 people.
- Link to survey forwarded from NEN Leadership team to neighbors.
- Hard copy postcards with link to survey distributed in several ways:
 - o Mailed to every household in Northeast Eugene
 - o Door-to-door distribution to Delta Oaks and Crescent Village businesses, as well as some neighborhoods in Northeast Eugene.
 - o On the street outside Gilham Elementary on two occasions.
- Hard copy surveys distributed at the following events
 - o NEN General Membership Meeting
 - o Creekside Park opening celebration
 - o Cal Young Middle School lunch time (survey modified and shortened slightly to tailor to youth)
 - o Falconwood Village community dinner

Out of approximately 9,201 residents living in Northeast Eugene, 641 surveys were completed between early May and early August of 2013, a 7% response rate.

Demographics

Overall, the survey results well represent the demographics of the neighborhood. The majority of survey respondents were slightly older than the average Northeast resident. They were more likely to be female and own a home.

Results Summary

How do people in Northeast Eugene travel around?

- 89% use a motor vehicle most or all of the time
- 73% walk some, most or all the time.
- 51% bike some, most or all the time
- 10% take the bus some, most or all the time.

Where do people go in the neighborhood?

- Over 50% of respondents go to school, work, church, and childcare facilities outside of NE Eugene.
- 94% shop in the neighborhood by driving, and 21% walk to restaurants or retail
- Parks and visiting friends are two destinations that inspire people to get out of their car: 29% bike and 55% walk to parks, and 20% bike and 37% walk to visit friends or family.

How do people feel about walking and biking in the neighborhood?

- 56% of respondents think there is a problem with accidents or conflicts between vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists.
- 61% of respondents are interested in changes to make it easier to walk and bike.

What would help people walk or bike more? The following list focuses on factors that can be changed (unlike the weather):

- Services or places were closer to home: 57%
- Less traffic: 47%
- More crosswalks, sidewalks, bike lanes: 40-45%
- Friends or family asked me to walk or bike with them: 41%

What are specific problem locations or suggested improvements?

“What change would you like to see in your neighborhood that would make it easier or more appealing for you or your family to get around by walking, biking or taking the bus?” Open-ended responses were coded, consolidated, and the following chart shows the number of times suggestions were in the survey response.

A brief comparison of how different demographic groups answered questions revealed the following:

- Youth: 38% of individuals under 18 don't have a bike, and 43% need their bike to work better. 62% said they would walk or bike more if friends or family asked them to. 50% of youth are driven to school, the other 50% are evenly split between bus, bike and walk.
- Low-income: People in poverty are 30% more likely to drive all the time than the average respondent. 14% of low-income respondents walk all the time, compared with 3% of wealthier respondents. 30% take the bus on a regular basis, compared with 10% of wealthier respondents.
